Guidelines for Mooney Scholar selection:

- Applicant must be the child of a member (in good standing) of the Ohio Federation of Teachers or the child of any staff person who is employed by OFT or its locals
- Applicant must be a graduating traditional public high school senior
- Academic Achievement GPA: 3.0 or higher preferred
- A high school transcript must be provided
- Applicant must already have been accepted to an accredited college or university
- Application must include a letter of recommendation from a teacher not related to the applicant
- Applicant must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular and community service activities
- Applicant must provide an essay stating how he or she is committed to the passions that Tom Mooney exemplified
- Application must include a signature of the applicant's parent (or legal guardian) and the President of the OFT Local in which the parent (or legal guardian) is a member

*If there are issues in obtaining any of these documents due to school closure, please notate that on your application.

Other Guidelines:

- Monies will be awarded upon proof of enrollment
- Scholarship is offered for one year and is non-renewable
- All awards are at the discretion of the Tom Mooney Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee
